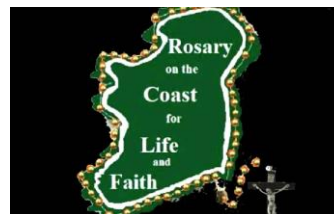

The Coastal Rosary



Over the last two months over a million Polish faithful travelled to the borders of their country to pray for the preservation of the faith, including the protection of the Unborn Child in Poland. Inspired by the Polish "Rosary at the Borders", Italian faithful held a similar "Rosary on the Border" for the same intention. On the Feast of Christ the King, Sunday 26th November, it is Ireland's turn! Ireland's faithful are turning out in great numbers to pray for a great restoration of the faith especially among the youth, and to pray for protection for our unborn babies in Ireland, North and South.
