**Parish Lotto**



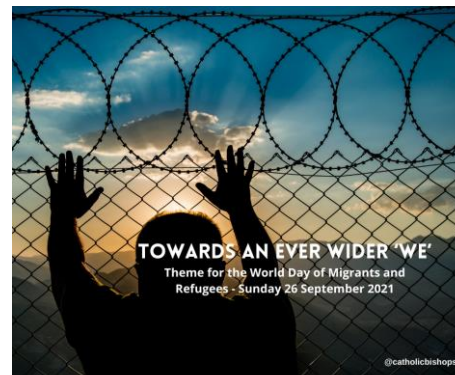
