Guidelines for our Church

It is recommended that you wear a mask inside the church
Please come 15 minutes before Mass
Entry is Via the Main door only
Please keep 2 metres distance from others both inside and outside the church.
Please sanitise your hands on the way in
Seats will be marked with an Angel for distance so please sit with an Angel.
You will be directed to your seat
There will be a section for Families and couples.
Holy Communion will be distributed one section at a time. You will be directed when to approach the Altar, keeping 2 metres from the person before you.
Exit the church after Mass to your right, keeping your physical distance.
Sanitiser will be at the exit doors.
Please do not congregate outside
Please observe respiratory etiquette (cough, sneeze into a paper hanky and discard or into your elbow)

If you are in a vulnerable category or have any symptoms eg cough, fever please stay at home. You can join us at Mass by webcam every Weekday at 10am and every Sunday at 10.30am.

As there are no basket collections at the moment we have one container on the way out for ALL collections 1st (Priests) 2nd (Share) and all envelopes.
