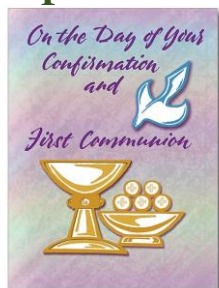


The Twenty fourth Sunday In Ordinary Time 12th September 2021
