

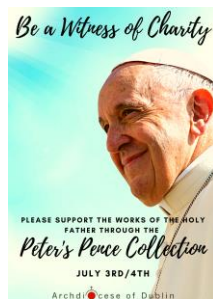
The Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary 11th July 2021
