Reopening for Public Mass on June 29th 2020

New Guidelines:

It is recommended that you wear a mask inside the church

Please come 15 minutes before Mass

Entry is Via the Main door only

Please keep 2 metres distance from others both inside and outside the church.

Please sanitise your hands on the way in

First collection will be as you come in the front door.

Seats will be marked with an Angel for distance so please sit with an Angel.

You will be directed to your seat
There will be a section for Families and couples.

Holy Communion will be distributed one section at a time. You will be directed when to approach the Altar,

keeping 2 metres from the person before you.

The priest will be behind a Perspex screen.

Extend your hands under the screen to receive the Blessed Sacrament.

Exit the church after Mass to the right keeping your physical distance.

Sanitiser will be at the exit doors.

Second collection will be on your way out.

Please do not congregate outside

Please observe respiratory etiquette (Cough, Sneeze into your elbow or a paper hanky and discard)

If you are in a vulnerable category or have any symptoms eg cough, please stay at home. You can join us at Mass by Webcam every Weekday at 10am and every Sunday at 10am.
